- E1092 Beverly Sills bearded iris** pkg of 3/\$14 Pale pink and apricot. Fast growing and heavy blooming. E-MS Z4-8 30-35"
- E1172 Gay Cravat daylily** pkg of 3/\$12 Pale yellow to pink. Low maintenance. mid Z4-8 27"
- E1212 Stella de Oro daylily** pkg of 3/\$12 Golden yellow and fragrant. A compact plant with lengthy blooming season starts early. Z3-9 12-18"
- E1241 'Victor Hugo' peony** pkg of 1/\$9 Ruby red to deep rose with double flowers. Z3 early SU 28-30"
- 2221 German extra-hardy garlic** – 3 bulbs/\$10 Excellent storage. Forms 4-6 huge cloves.
- 2251 Russian Red garlic** - organic 3 bulbs/\$10 Z3-8 Large bulbed garlic w/stiff stalk. Forms one ring of 5-8 large plump cloves. Keeps well for ≈6 months.
- 2321 Bingo double amaryllis- (indoor bulb)** 1/\$10 Bright red double on 14" stalks. This is a showy plant for indoors. *These are for indoor forced bulb planting.*
- 5061 Pauline reticulata iris** 10 bulbs/\$4 Very dark purple with white crest. Z4-9 ES 3-6"
- 7462 Scilla siberica** pkg of 20/\$4 Bright flax blue small bell flowers. Hardy, prolific and lightly scented. Good naturalizer. Z2-8 ES 6-8"
- 5142 Susan Siberian Japanese iris** pkg of 3/\$11 Deep blue. Z4-9 SU 24-36"
- 7221 Rubra Maxima fritillaria** pkg of 1/\$7 Burnt orange-red with purple. Z5-7. MS, 26-30"
- 7322 Lollypop lily** pkg. of 3/\$9 Asiatic hybrid with hot pink and white flowers. Z3-8. early, 30-32"
- CROCUS Z 3-8 VE
- 3582 Cream Beauty** pkg of 20/\$5 Eggnog cream with bronze base. 3-4"
- 3731 Jumbo Crocus landscape mix** pkg of 40/\$10 larger scale naturalizing with 7-8 cm bulbs
- NARCISSUS-DAFFODIL Z 3-8
- 6161 Pink Pride** pkg of 5/\$6 White on white with pink rim. MS, 20-24"
- 6231 Tahiti** pkg of 5/\$6 Golden yellow long lasting and fragrant. MS-LS 14-18"
- 6242 White Lion** pkg of 10/\$9 White around yellow segments. Sturdy. MS 14-18"
- 6362 Minnow** pkg of 10/\$5 Small with white and pale yellow. Z5-9 ES-MS 8"
- 6472 Sunshine narcissus mix** pkg of 20/\$9 Mix of bicolor cupped flowers in all colors. MS 14-18"
- TULIPS Z 3-7
- 9042 Giuseppe Verdi** 10 bulbs/\$7 Rose with yellow edges. VE 10-12"
- 9162 Happy Fammily** pkg of 10/\$8 Rich pink with lighter edges. Multiple blooms MS 18-20
- 9232 Dbl Red Riding Hood** pkg of 10/\$7 Large red with orange inside. 12-14" MS
- 9422 HooHaa Blend** pkg of 20/\$11 Mix of reds and deep purples. 20-28" LS
